Are you home educating? If so Nottingham College offers a bespoke range of courses for electively home educated young people. Our Pre-GCSE and GCSE programmes go from strength to strength and we continue to offer Year 11 infill placements as well as discrete vocational courses.

Pre-GCSE Programme Adams Building

This one year programme is for students in Year 9-11 and will provide students with the skills that they need to progress on to a GCSE or vocational full time programme.

- Level 1 or 2 Functional Skills in English and maths
- BTEC Level 1 Certificate in Applied Science
- Tutorial and Enrichment programme that includes: Personal & Social Development and Employability & Progression skills

Year 11 Infill Programme

We offer the opportunity for Home Educated students who are in Year 11 to infill onto our Post-16, full-time vocational courses. This means students will study alongside our 16-18 year students.

Placements are available in a wide range of curriculum areas including: Art & Design, Animal Science, Automotive, IT, Beauty, Care & Early Years, Construction, Engineering, Hair, Hospitality & Catering, Supported Learning (SLDD), Music, Performing Arts, Media, Photography, Science and Sport.

GCSE Programme Adams Building

This one year programme is for Year 10-11 students who are ready to undertake a GCSE programme (determined by gaining a grade 3 or above in English and maths at initial assessment).

Students can choose up to 4 subjects from the list below:

- GCSE English
- GCSE Maths
- GCSE History
- GCSE Religious Studies
- GCSE Double Science [^]
- GCSE Psychology
- GCSE Sociology

Half-day, short vocational programmes

Nottingham College also offers half-day Level 1 vocational programmes in ICT, Catering and Art & Design. Students can study one of these alongside the Pre-GCSE programme*, as part of their GCSE programme* or as standalone courses.
